I was the main facilitator and taught the group new rhythms and songs for performances.

Events, Teaching and Grants

Jul-Aug 2021, 2019 - 2010 Eastend Historical Museum. 5 week watercolour, acrylic, sculpture and drumming workshops teaching up to 20 participants.

Oct 2019 - Mar 2020 'Making Art Together' Six month workshop sessions created from Bringing People together 'Art as Healing' Sask Arts Board Artist in Community Grant with Eastend Historical Museum. This six month workshop that I created and facilitated included many mediums. Watercolour, acrylic, writing, Lantern building, movement, and drumming. Had up to 20 participants.

Mar 2019 - Making Art Together - Art as Healing - Sask Arts micro grant. A full day of art and drumming workshop for community of Eastend SK Isolation from grief, sadness, depression, financial lack, transportation etc. 25 participants attended and had 3 volunteers assisting. This was a pilot project to see if the community would participate in a 6 month workshop series. The positive response was very encouraging.

September 2016 - 2019 SaskCulture Days Facilitated drum circles, art projects and art walks during Culture Days for the community of Eastend SK and surrounding areas.

2012 - 2022- Brady Coulee Artist Retreat - Curated and Juried by Dean Bauche. A yearly curated artist retreat that brings many disciplines together. I have participated as an artist and musician during these years.
